<sup>18</sup>Consequently, just as condemnation for all people came through one transgression, so too through the one righteous act came righteousness leading to life for all people. <sup>19</sup>For just as through the disobedience of the one man many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of one man many will be made righteous.

Life with a Purpose: Romans 12:1-3

<sup>1</sup>Therefore I exhort you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a sacrifice – alive, holy, and pleasing to God – which is your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup>Do not be conformed to this present world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may test and approve what is the will of God – what is good and well-pleasing and perfect. <sup>3</sup>For by the grace given to me I say to every one of you not to think more highly of yourself than you ought to think, but to think with sober discernment, as God has distributed to each of you a measure of faith.

## SUMMARY

Eternal Perspective: Jeremiah 29:10-43

<sup>10</sup>“For the Lord says, ‘Only when the seventy years of Babylonian rule are over will I again take up consideration for you. Then I will fulfill my gracious promise to you and restore you to your homeland.’ <sup>11</sup>For I know what I have planned for you,’ says the Lord. ‘I have plans to prosper you, not to harm you. I have plans to give you a future filled with hope.’ <sup>12</sup>When you call out to me and come to me in prayer, I will hear your prayers. <sup>13</sup>When you seek me in prayer and worship, you will find me available to you. If you seek me with all your heart and soul, <sup>14</sup>I will make myself available to you,’ says the Lord. ‘Then I will reverse your plight and will regather you from all the nations and all the places where I have exiled you,’ says the Lord. ‘I will bring you back to the place from which I exiled you.’
